

Chart Definitions and Technical Notes: State of the States 1-Pager for AIDD Website

CHART 1: Medicaid Spending as a Percentage of Total I/DD Services and Support Spending in 2013

The chart summarizes total I/DD spending in 2013 and the portion of spending consisting of federal-state Medicaid spending. Displayed on the pie chart are the proportions of total I/DD spending for a) the Medicaid Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) Waiver; b) Medicaid Intermediate Care Facilities for Intellectual Disability (ICF/ID); c) related Medicaid (administration, clinic/rehabilitative services, targeted case management, and personal assistance); d) state funds; and e) other federal funds.

Data for the chart are from the State I/DD Agency, and in some states from the state Medicaid, Social Services, or Health Agency.

CHART 2: Average Cost of Care per Person by Residential Setting in 2013

The column chart summarizes spending per participant in four types of residential settings in 2013. The settings are: 1) state-operated institutions serving 16 or more persons; 2) private and public ICFs/ID and other group homes for 7 or more persons; 3) private and public ICFs/ID and group homes and host homes for 6 or fewer persons per setting; and 6) supported living/personal assistance settings. In 10 states (AR, GA, IN, IA, NV, NM, NC, OH, TN, and WV) spending for 6 person or fewer settings was estimated based on the cost of other settings in that state (i.e., 7+ settings and Supported Living).

Data for the chart are from the State I/DD Agency.

CHART 3: Community Services Fiscal Effort for the State, Region and U.S.: 2003-2013

The line chart summarizes spending per \$1,000 of statewide aggregate personal income for the State, the Region and the U.S. during 2003 to 2013. The values are in dollars and cents.

State I/DD spending data are from the State I/DD Agency; personal income data are from the U.S. Department of Commerce, Bureau of Economic Analysis.

CHART 4: Public I/DD Spending for Family Support and Supported Living as a Percentage of Total I/DD Spending: 2003-2013

The column chart summarizes total I/DD spending, and what proportion of that spending is for children and adults in the family home (family support) and spending for adults in their own or a shared home (supported living).

State I/DD total spending and spending for family support and supported living are from the State I/DD Agency.
