

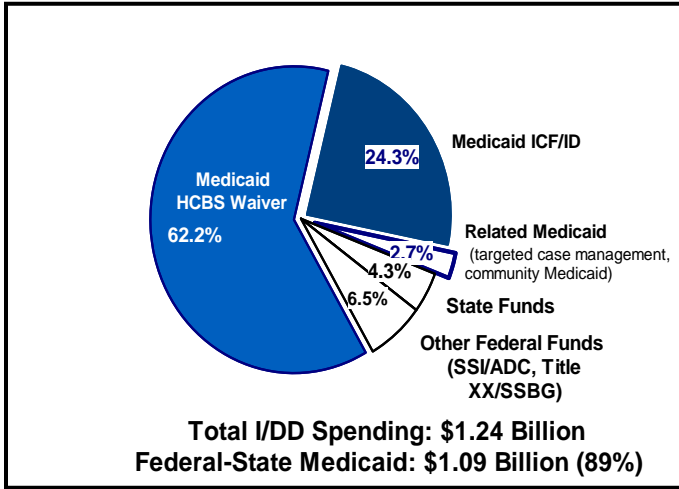
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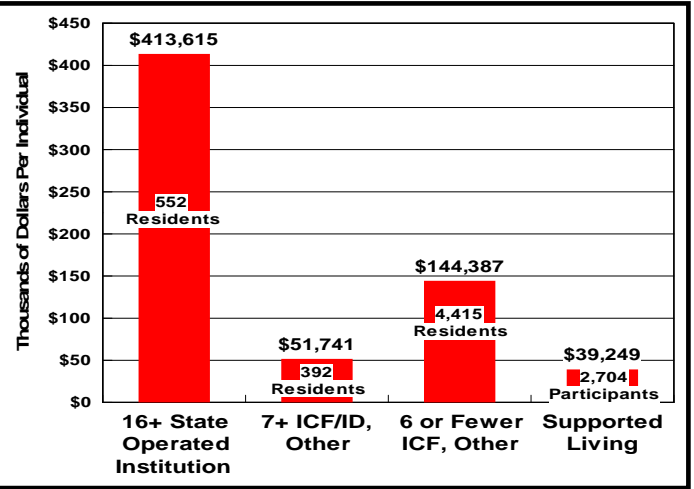

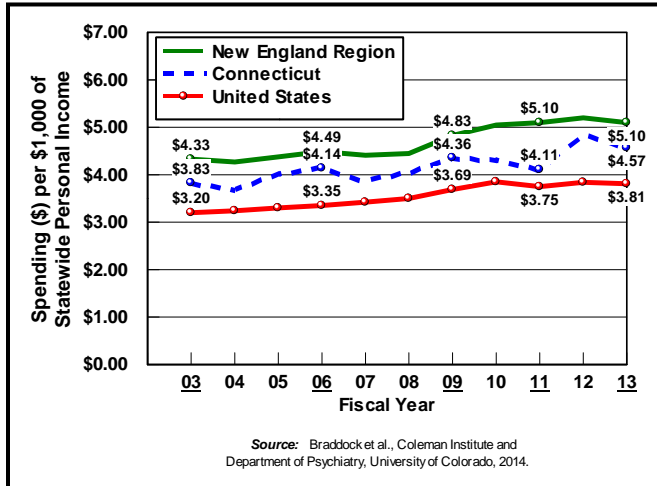
Medicaid Funds Constituted 89% of Total I/DD Services and Support Spending in Connecticut: FY 2013



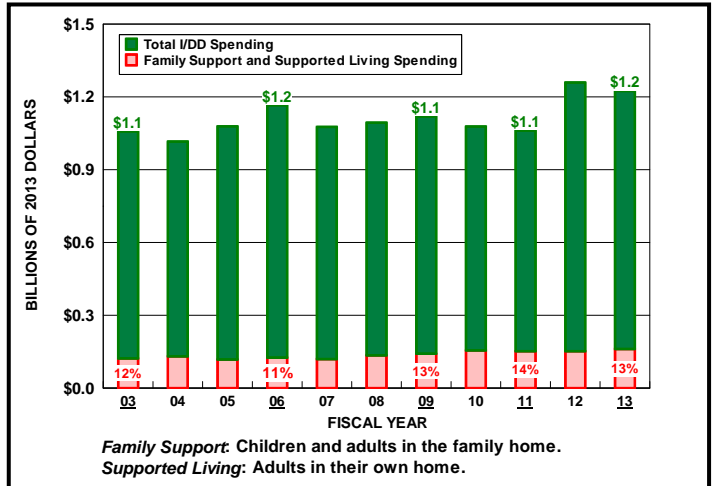
Average Cost of Care for Persons with I/DD by Residential Setting in Connecticut: FY 2013
