

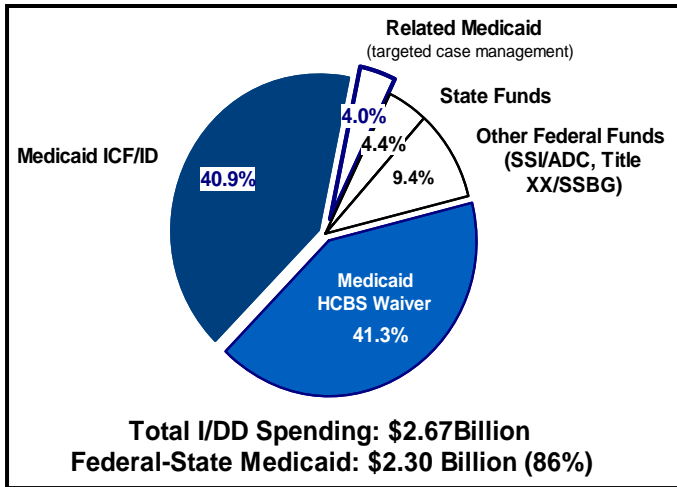

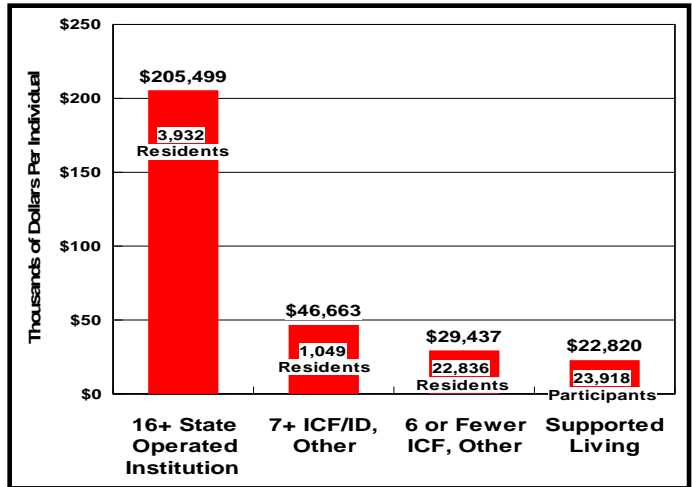

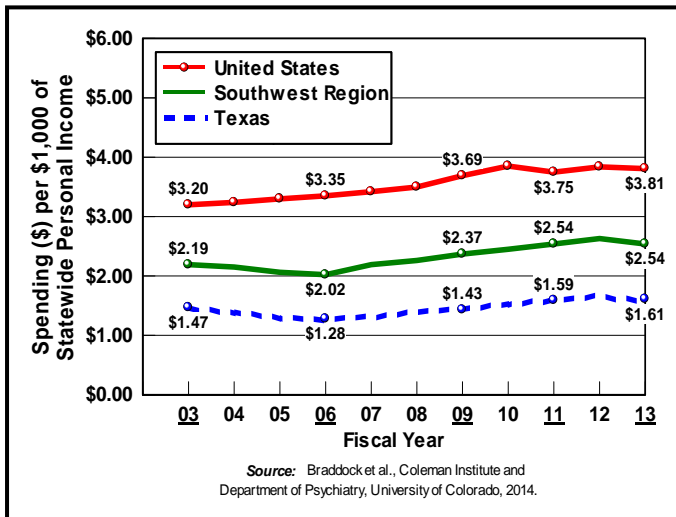
Medicaid Funds Constituted 86% of Total I/DD Services and Support Spending in Texas: FY 2013



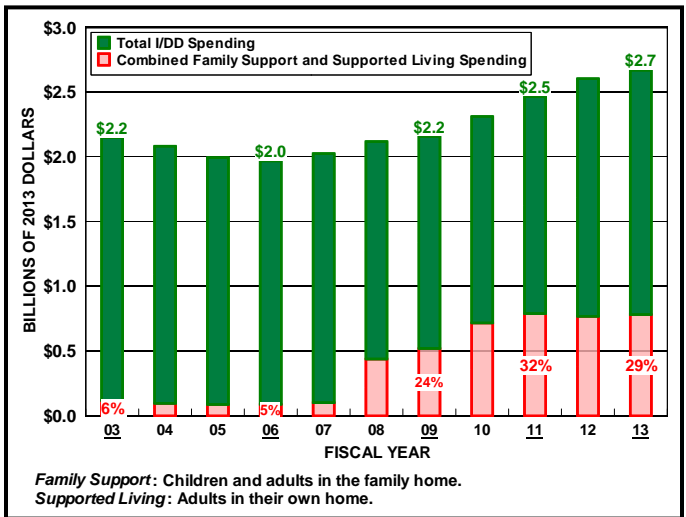
Average Cost of Care for Persons with I/DD by Residential Setting in Texas: FY 2013
