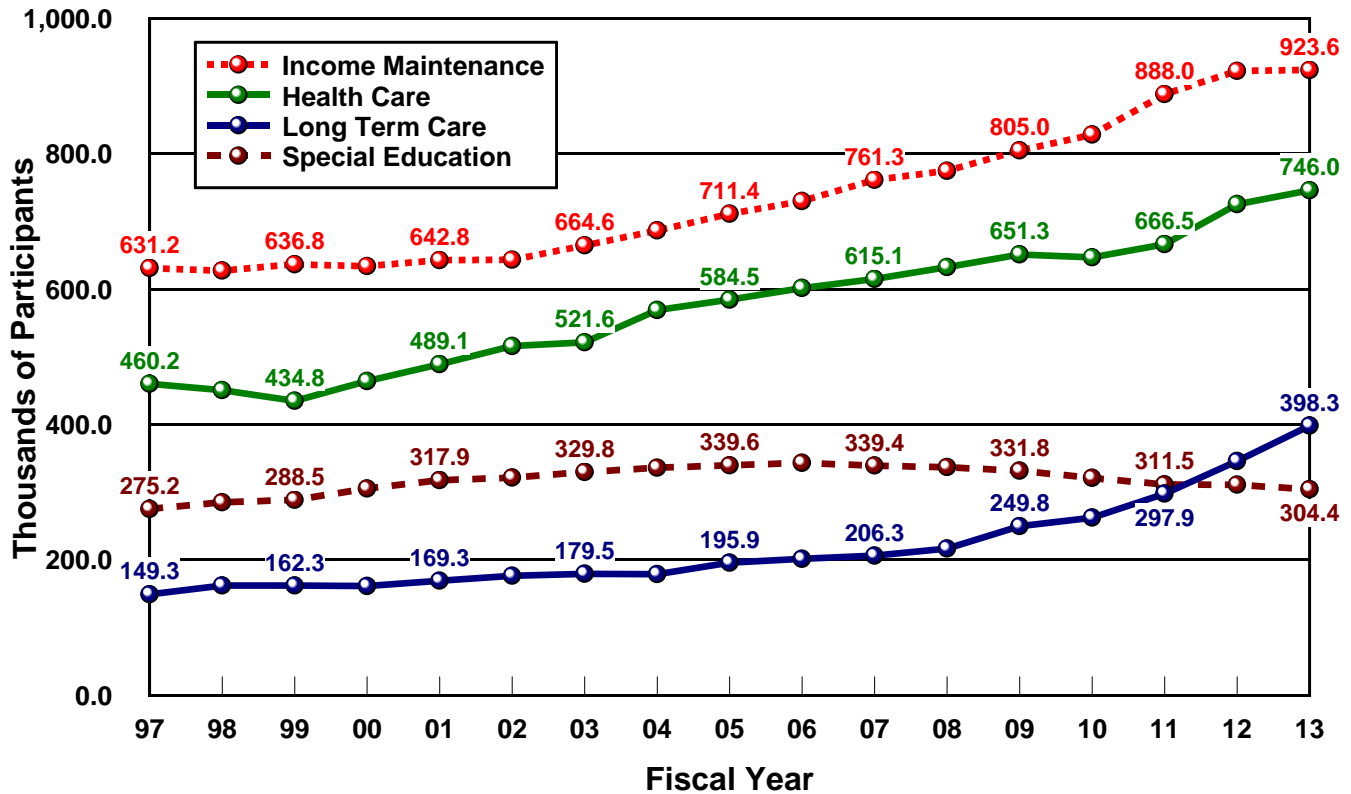

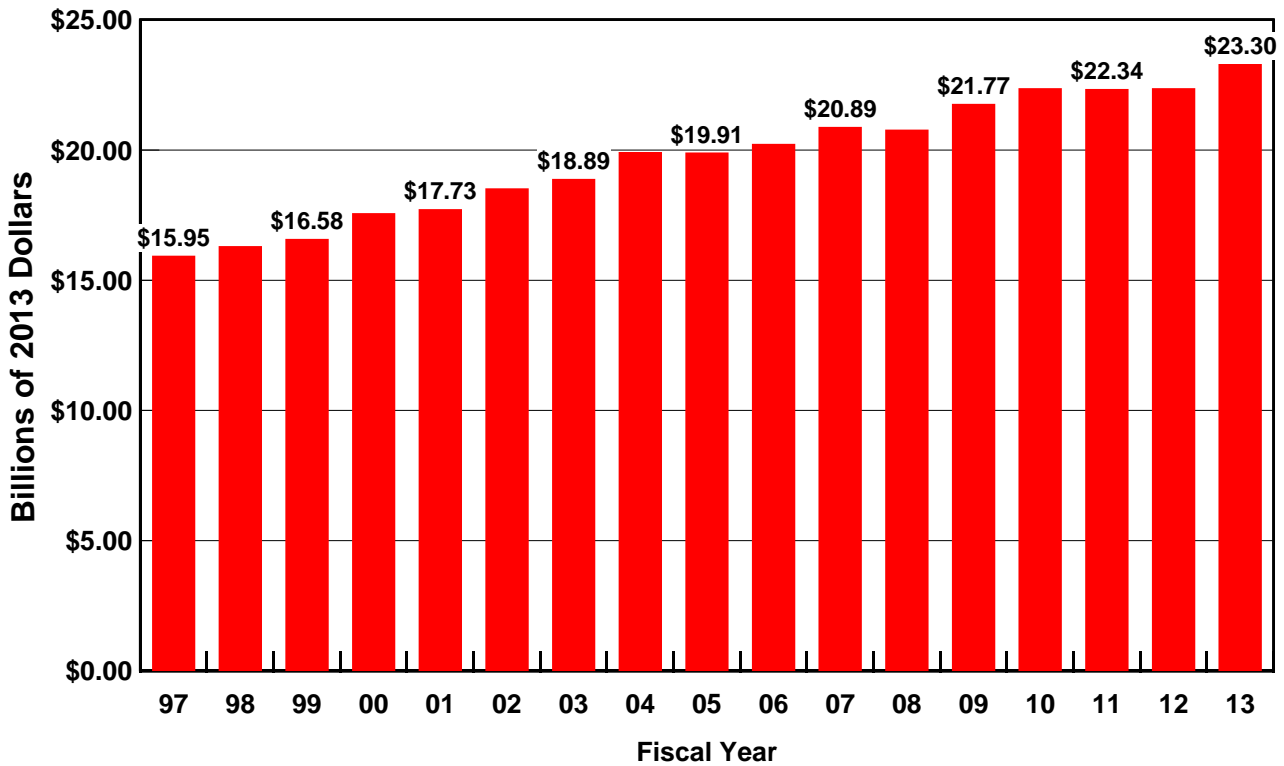

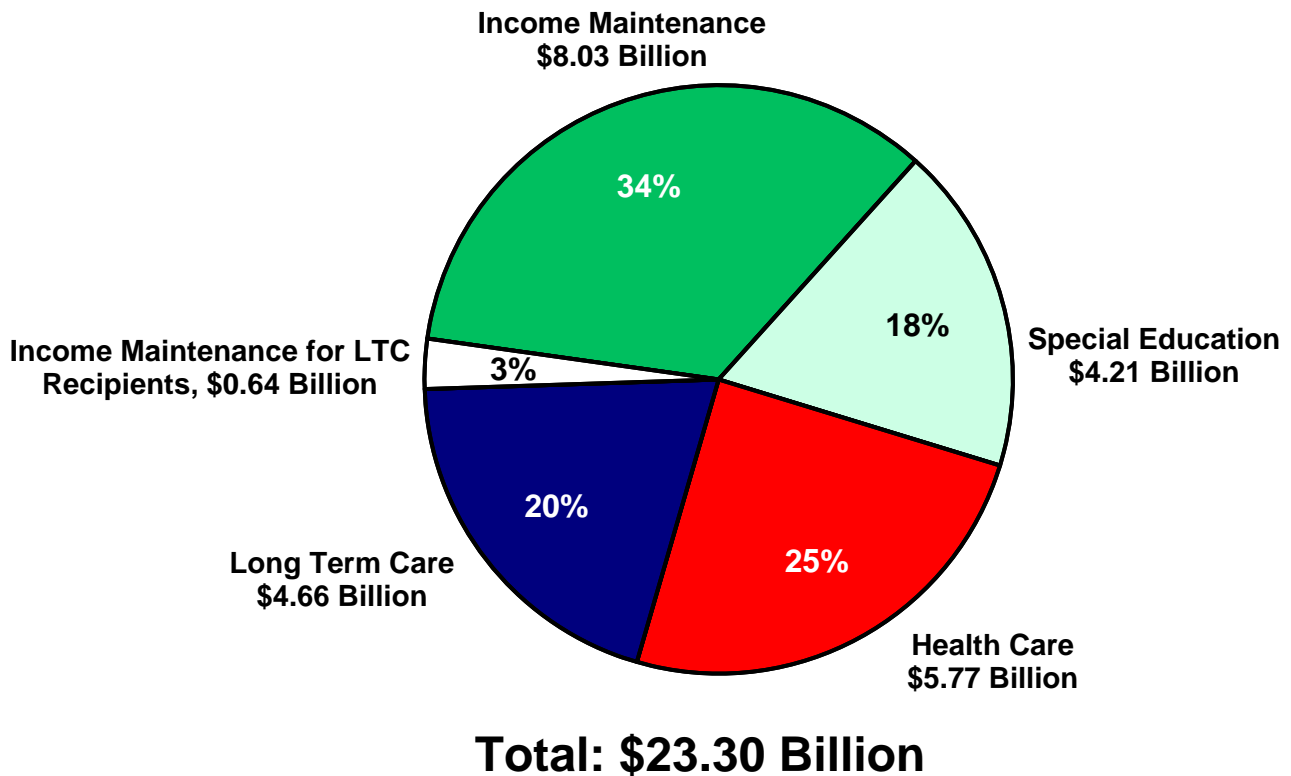

### TOTAL PUBLIC SPENDING FOR DISABILITY: 1997-2013

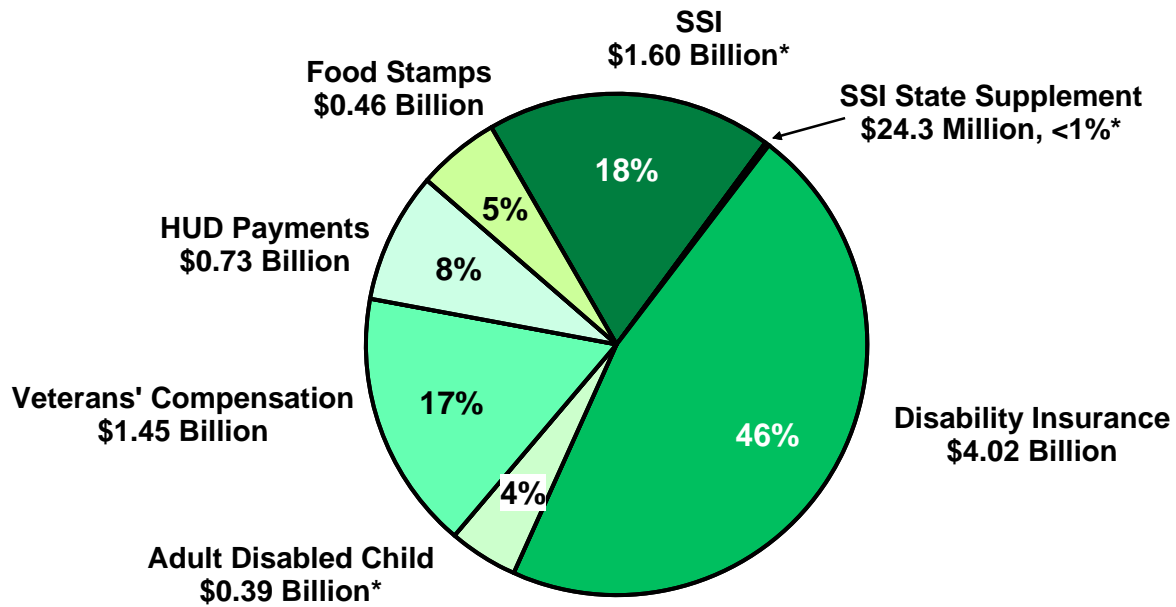


### PUBLIC SPENDING FOR DISABILITY BY CATEGORY: 2013

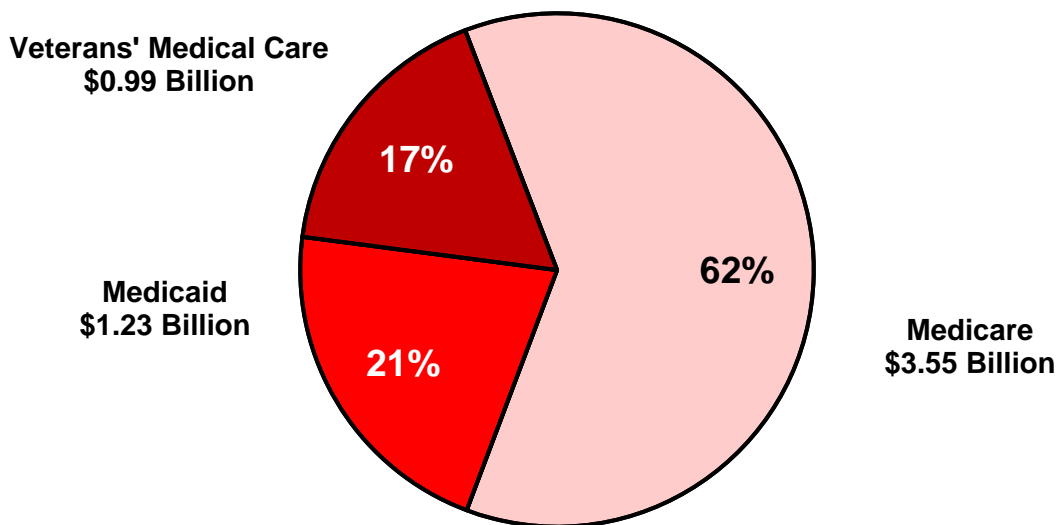
### DISABILITY INCOME MAINTENANCE: 2013

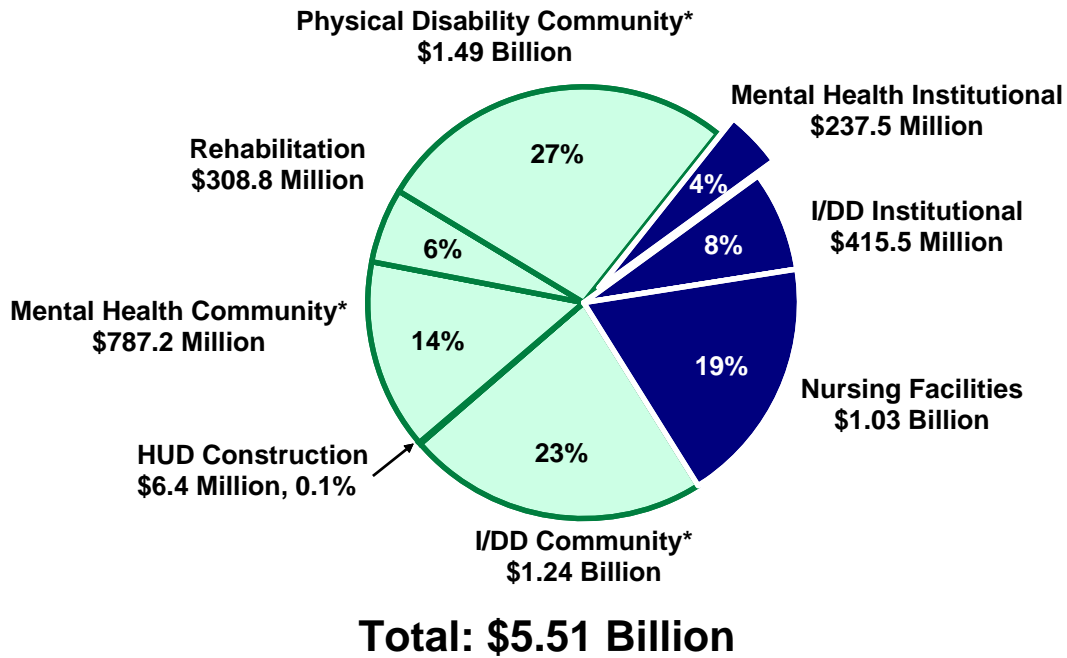

### HEALTH CARE SPENDING FOR DISABILITY: 2013



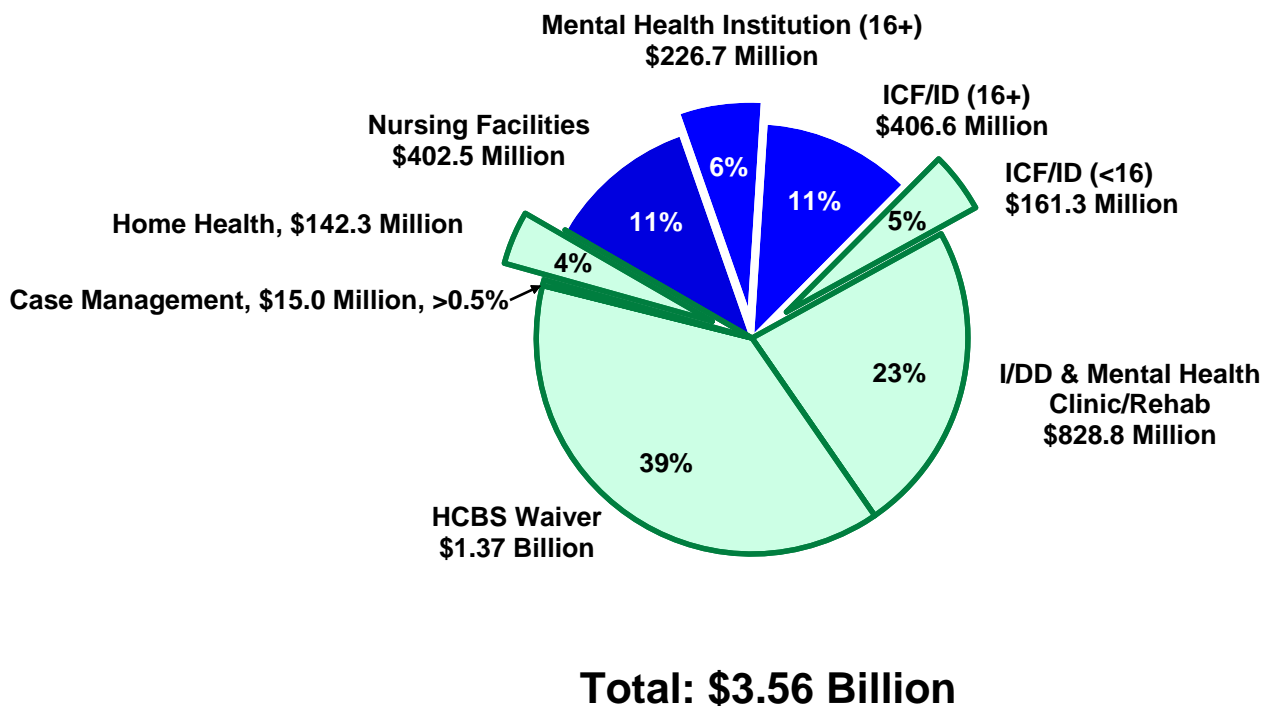

### TOTAL LONG TERM CARE SPENDING FOR DISABILITY: 2013

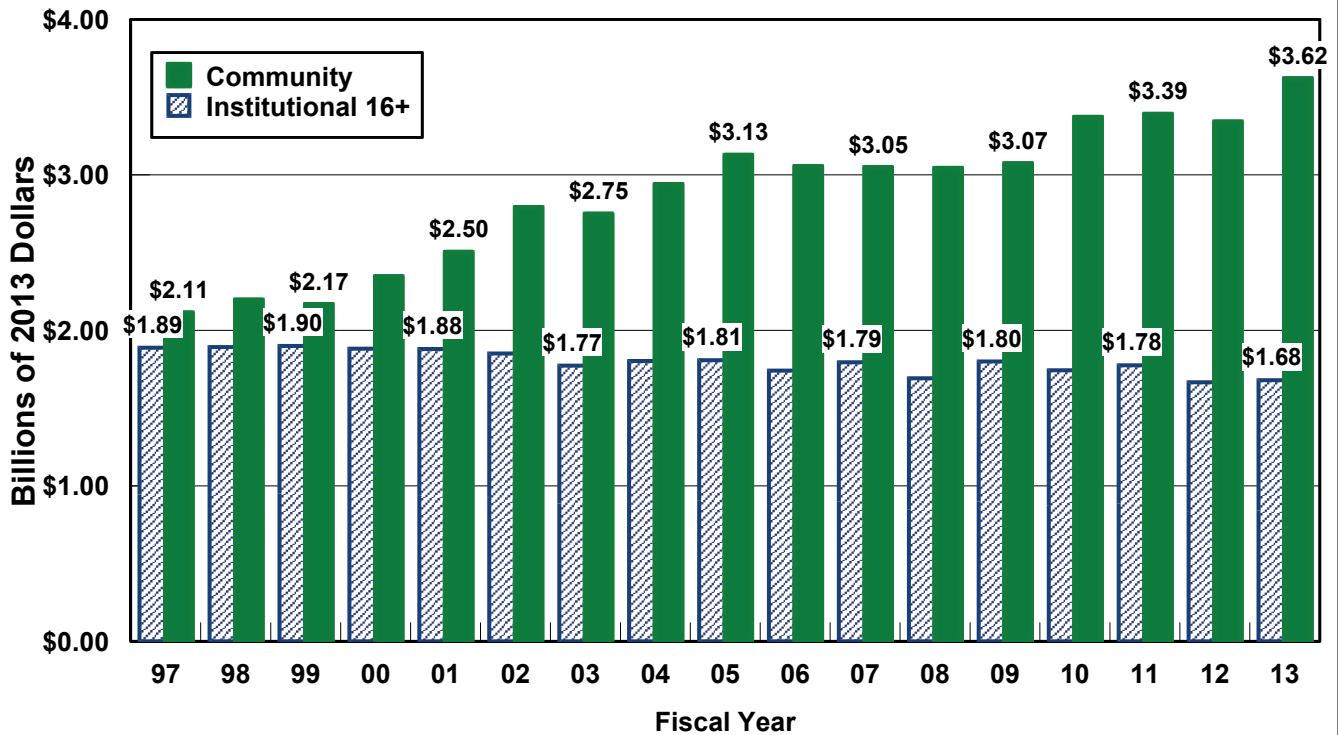

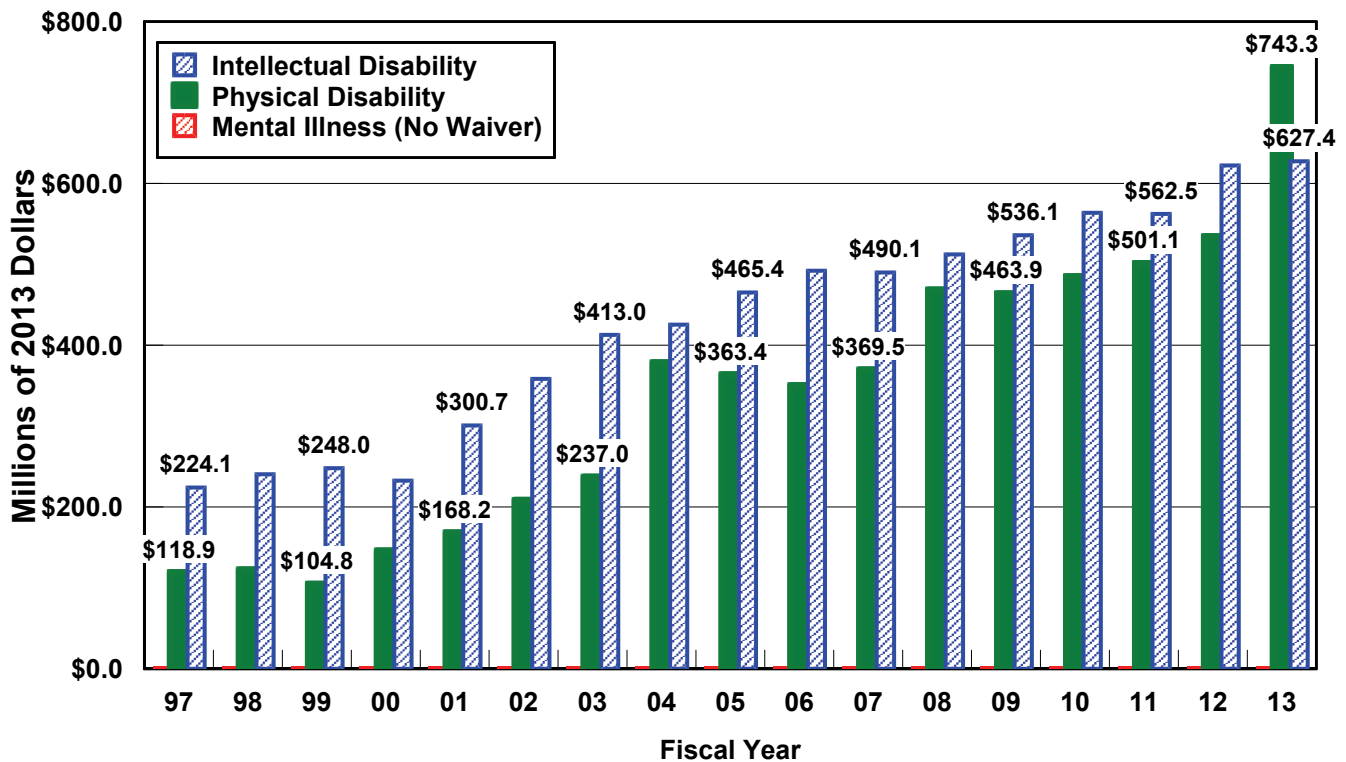
### MEDICAID LONG TERM CARE SPENDING FOR DISABILITY: 2013



### TOTAL LONG TERM CARE SPENDING FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES: 1997-2013

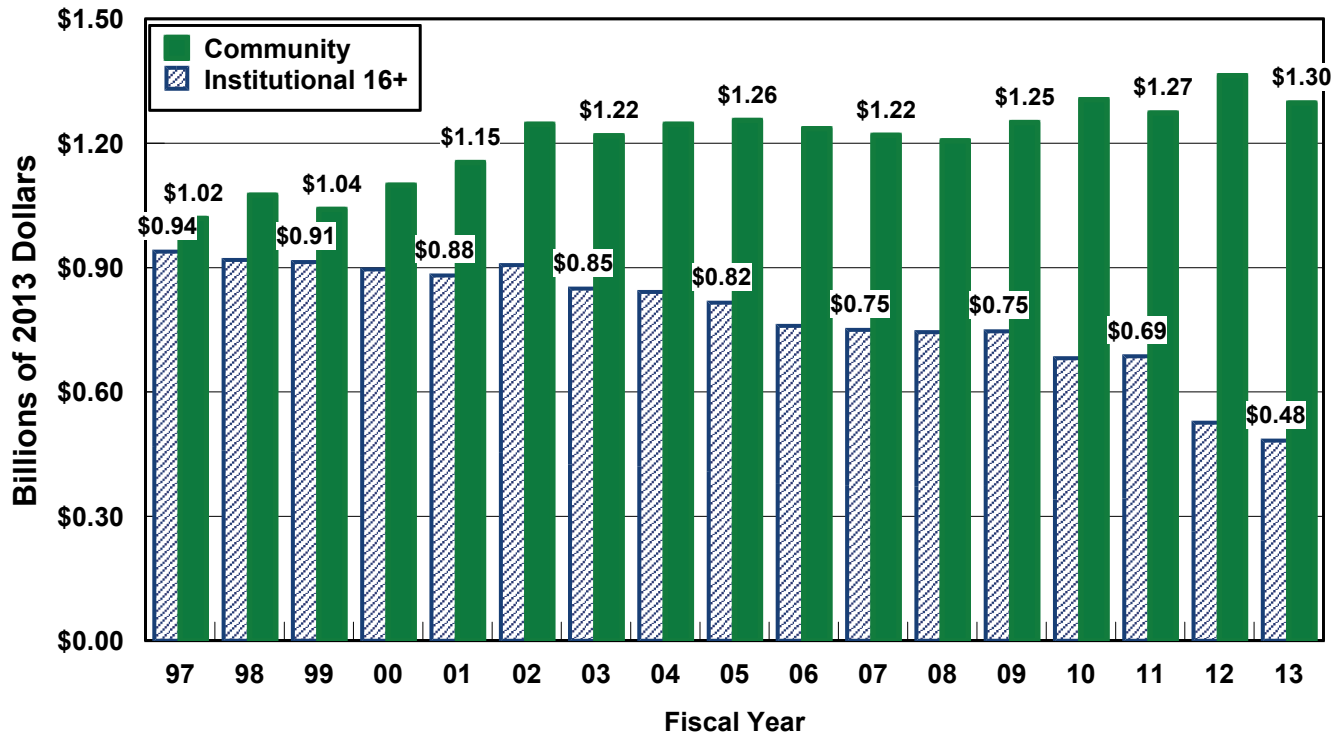


### GROWTH OF THE HOME AND COMMUNITY BASED SERVICES WAIVER: 1997-2013

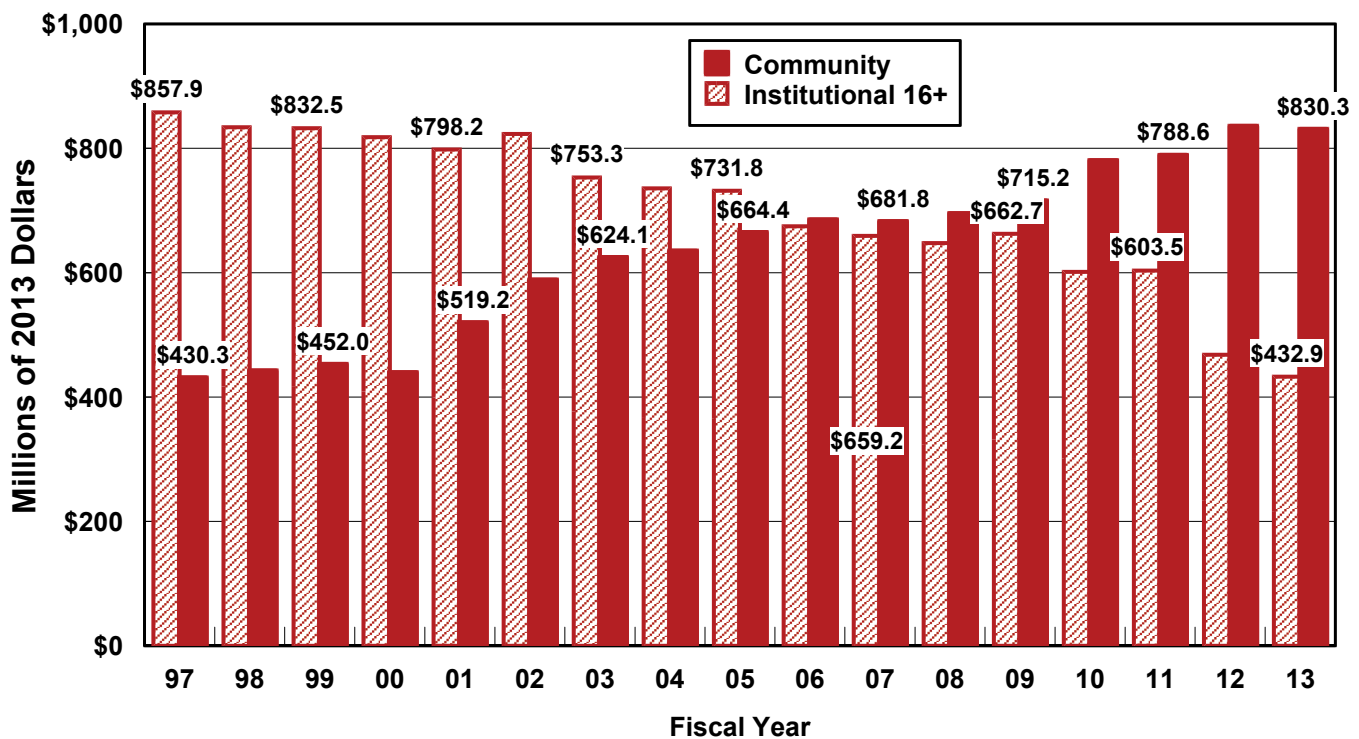

### TOTAL LONG TERM CARE SPENDING FOR INTELLECTUAL DISABILITY: 1997-2013

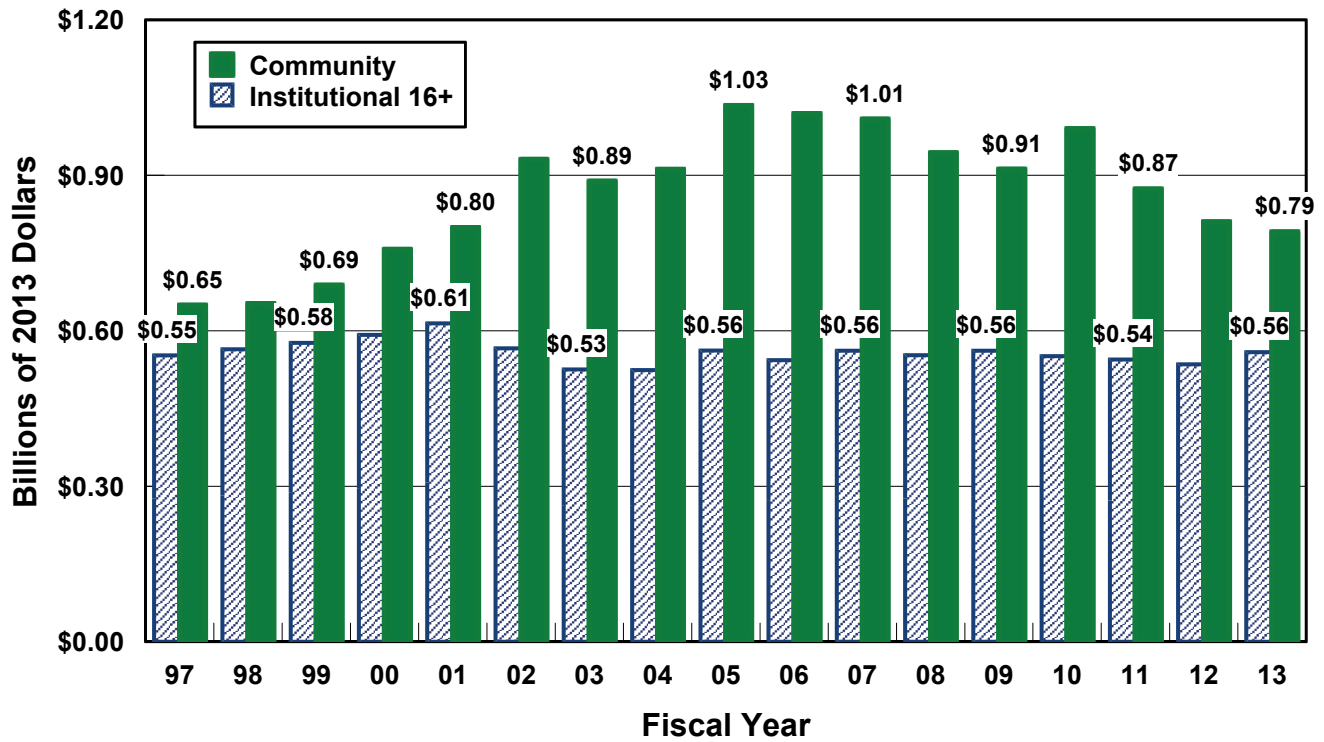


### MEDICAID LONG TERM CARE SPENDING FOR INTELLECTUAL DISABILITY: 1997-2013

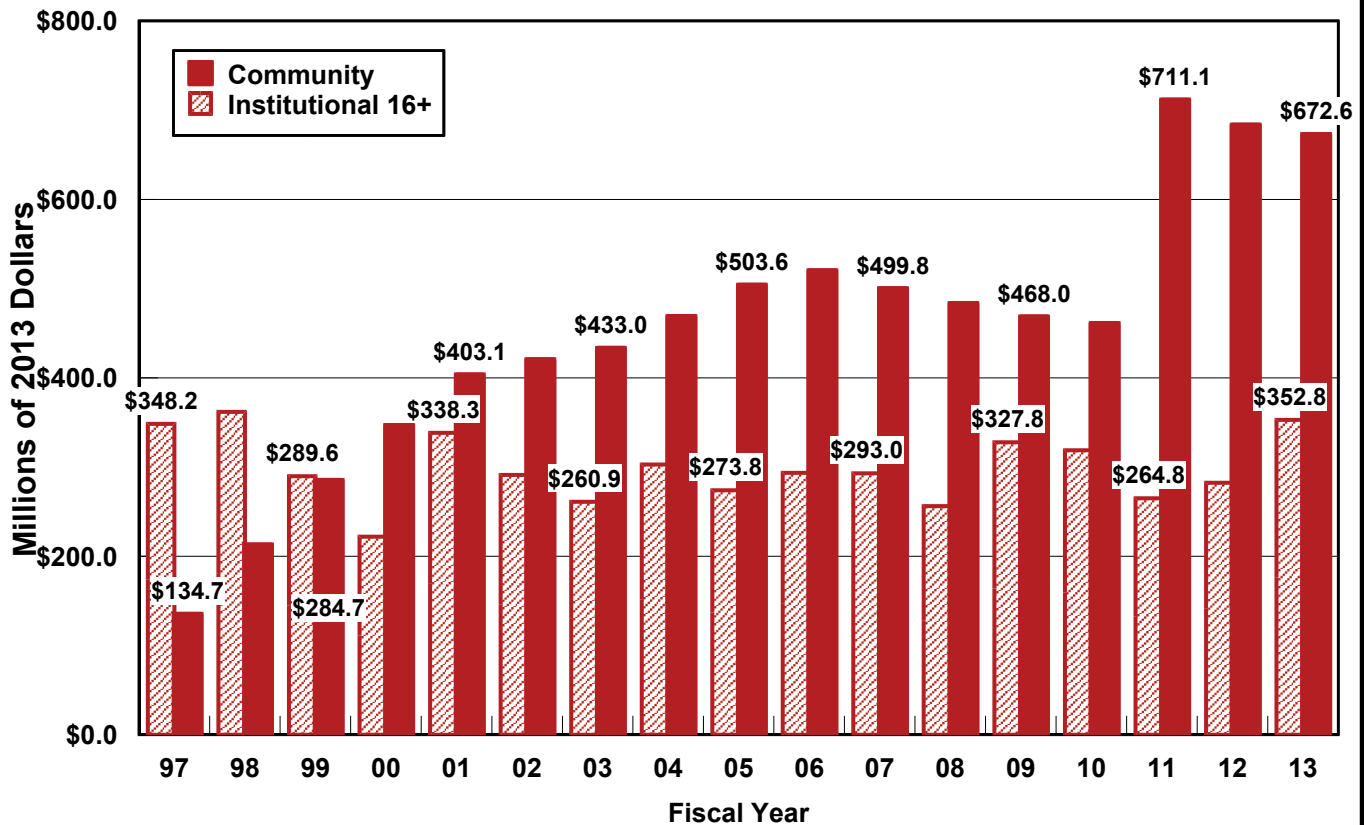

### TOTAL LONG TERM CARE SPENDING FOR MENTAL HEALTH: 1997-2013

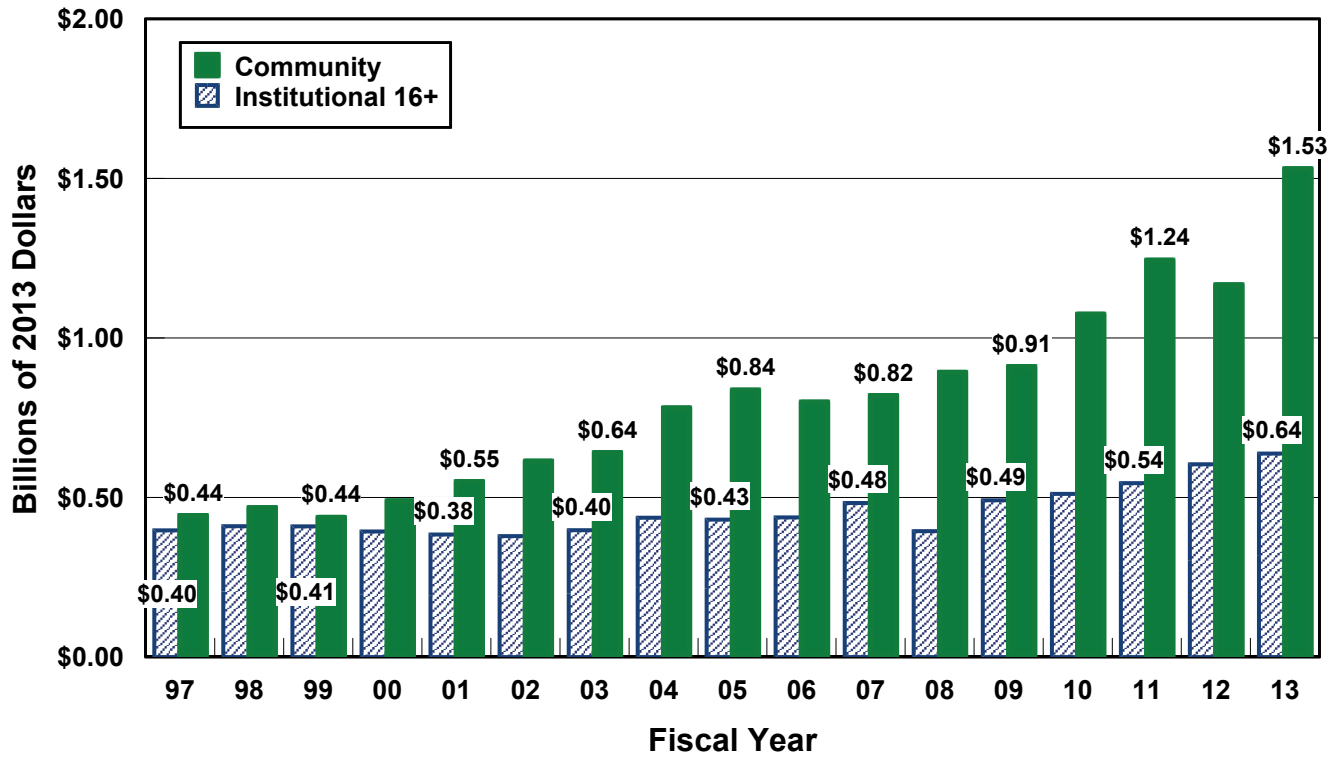


### MEDICAID LONG TERM CARE SPENDING FOR MENTAL HEALTH: 1997-2013

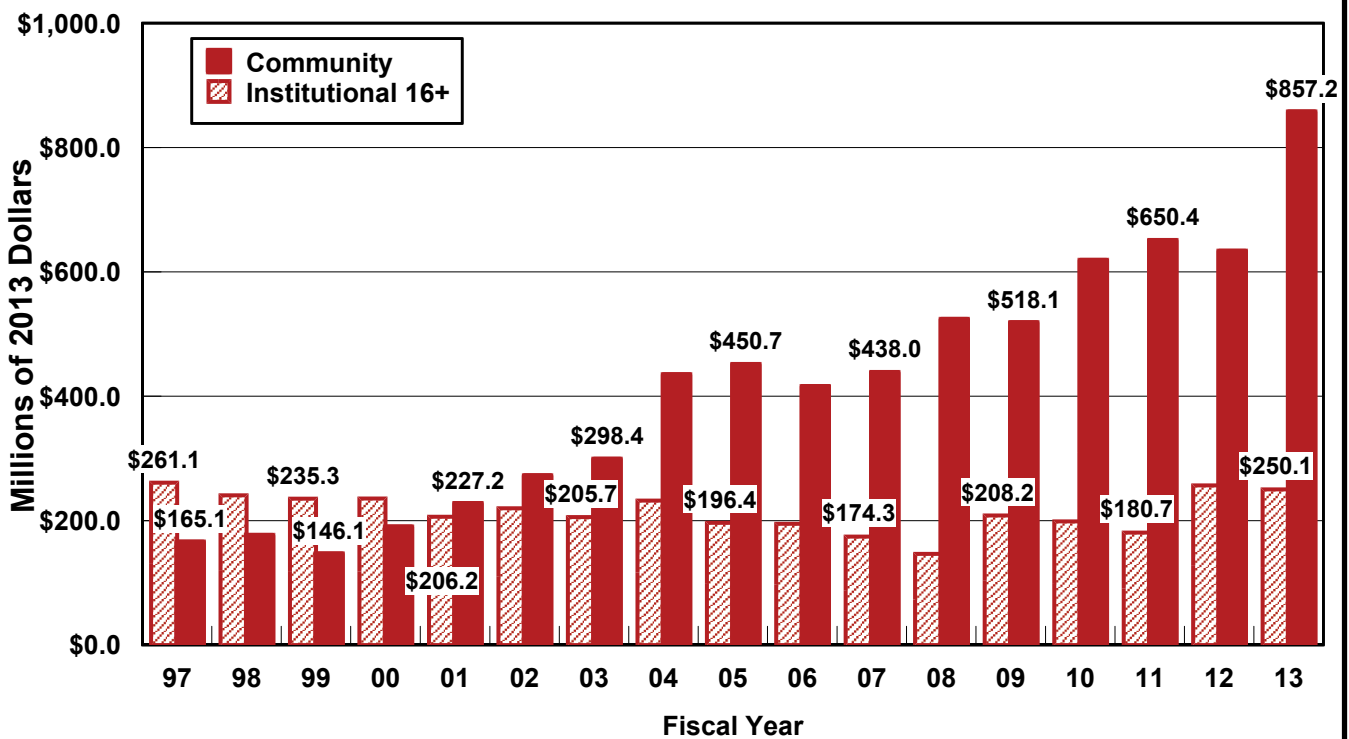

### TOTAL LONG TERM CARE SPENDING FOR PHYSICAL DISABILITIES: 1997-2013



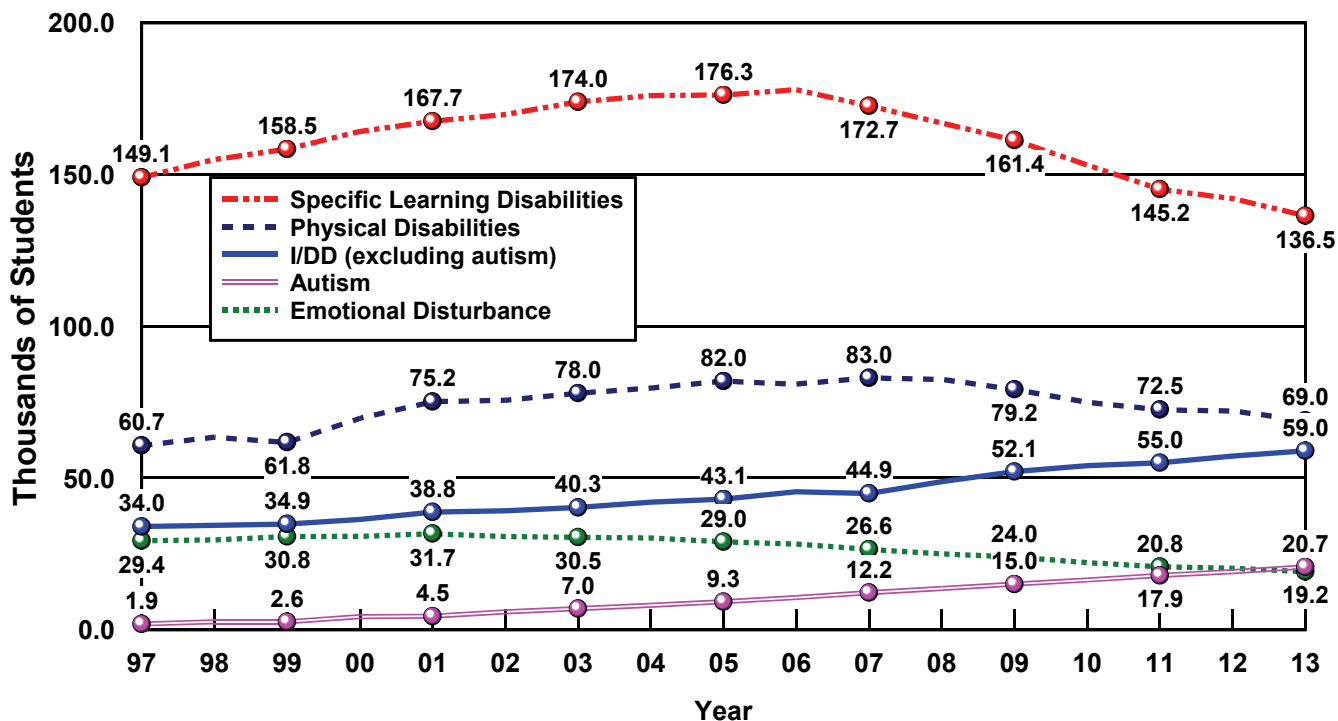
### MEDICAID LONG TERM CARE SPENDING FOR PHYSICAL DISABILITIES: 1997-2013



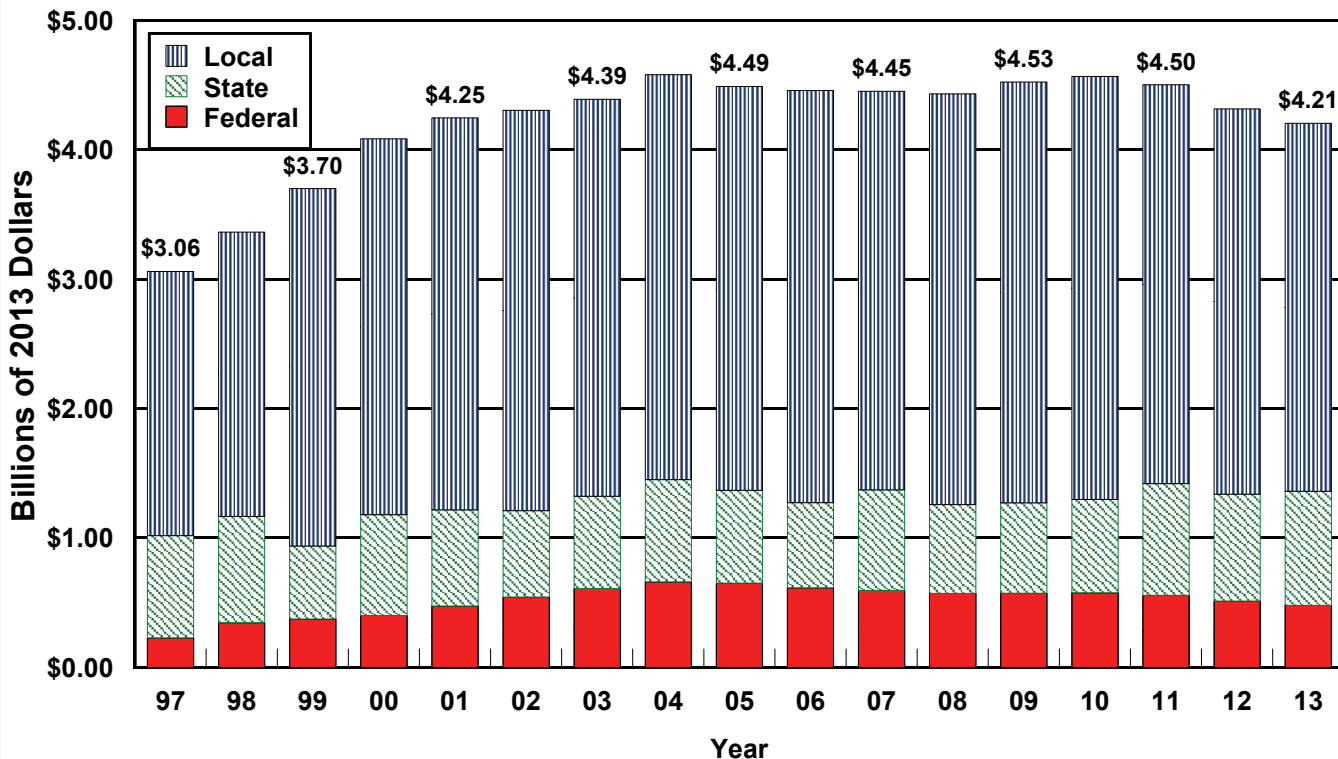
