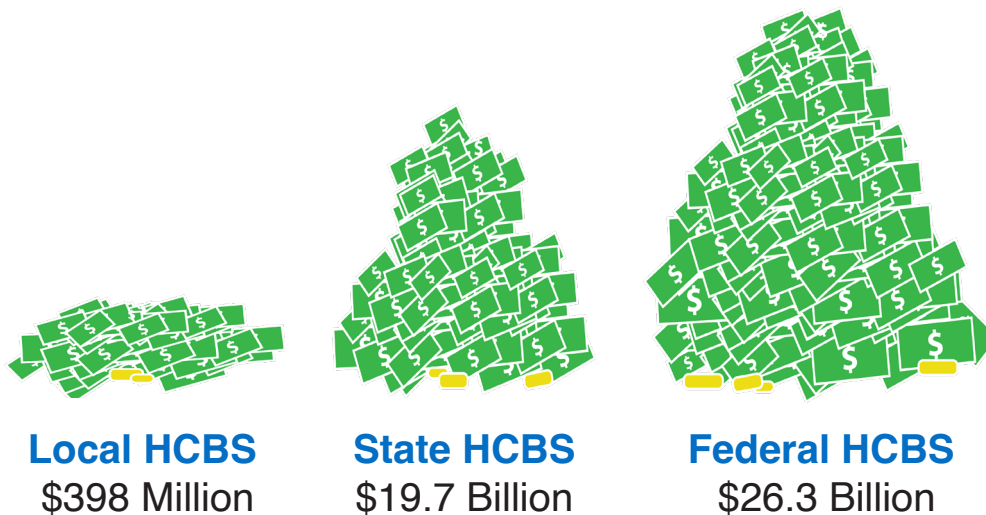

Question: What is the **total amount of money spent on Home- and Community-Based Services (HCBS) for people with IDD in 2019?**



In **FY 2019**, a total of **\$46.5 Billion** was spent on **HCBS**.

- **\$26.3 Billion** was spent on **Federal HCBS**.
- **\$19.7 Billion** was spent on **State HCBS**.
- **\$398 Million** was spent on **Local HCBS**.

The State of the States in Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities Project is a national longitudinal comparative study of financial and programmatic trends in spending on supports and services for people with intellectual/developmental disabilities (IDD) in the United States. The project is funded by the U.S. Administration on Community Living as a Longitudinal Data Project of National Significance.

Definitions

Home- and Community-Based Services (HCBS): provide opportunities for **Medicaid beneficiaries** to **receive services** in **their own home or community** rather than **in institutions or other isolated settings**.
